New Subway opened at Saidapet

Subway has been newly built near Open University, Govt. College of Education in Saidapet for the benefit of the Passengers and public. The recently opened Subway has been built in replacement for the subway, which was earlier demolished by CMRL for construction purposes.

The subway can be utilized by pedestrians and passengers travelling in Metro Rail and MTC for crossing either side of the highly traffic area of Saidapet.



CMRL - Bi-Cycle Scheme

As part of providing last mile connectivity to Metro Rail Stations, Several Bi-Cycle Schemes have been introduced at CMRL Metro stations for the benefit of the passengers and to promote a healthier and sustainable mode of transport.

The Three Bi-cycle Schemes namely CMRL Bi-cycle Scheme from January 2017 at 12 Metro stations namely Nehru park, Kilpauk, Pachaiyappa's College, Shenoy Nagar, Anna Nagar Tower, Thirumangalam, Koyambedu, Ashok nagar, Ekkattuthangal, Alandur, St. Thomas Mount, Little Mount, A GPS enabled bi-cycle scheme by PEDL Bi-cycle Scheme by Zoom Car from October 2017 at 3 Metro Stations namely Thirumangalam, Anna Nagar tower, Anna Nagar East and 100 hours of free rides bi-cycle scheme by Athi's Cycles from October 2017 at 6 Metro Stations namely Nehru park, Shenoy Nagar, Anna Nagar East, Thirumangalam, Vadapalani, Ashok Nagar have been provided at various underground and elevated metro stations have garnered an over whelming response from the Chennai Public for the above schemes.

A total number of 50,500 trips have been availed from metro stations since introducing CMRL Bi-cycle Scheme, 36,450 no's of trips have been availed through the PEDL Bi-cycle Scheme and 14,580 no's of trips have been availed through Athi's Cycles Scheme.

Several Last Mile Connectivity facilities and schemes have also been introduced for the benefit of the passengers.

- (I) Feeder Services (Small Buses) connecting Metro Stations to several routes have been introduced.
- (ii) CMRL entered an agreement with M/s. OLA & UBER- cab aggregators, to install counters at 16 Metro Stations for last mile connectivity.
- (iii) Bike Rental Services: A pilot project with a bike rental service provider- M/s SFA Motorcycle Rentals has commenced at Thirumangalam & Airport Metro stations from 3rd week of February 2018.
- (iv) Buggy services are available at Airport & Vadapalani
- **(v)** Travelator connecting Airport Metro Station and Chennai Airport

Man held for fake job offers in metro rail

The central crime branch of Chennai police arrested a man for duping youngsters with fake job offers in Chennai metro rail, on Sunday.

The arrested person was identified as A. Mariadoss alias Dinesh (41) of Ayanavaram.

The CCB police commenced an investigation after the general manager (HR) of metro rail filed a fake job racket complaint last month.

A north Indian gang was behind this and they collected nearly ₹30,000 from many job aspirants. The miscreants had advertised the 'job' opportunity in

metro rail on local television channels.

The scam came to light after youngsters approached metro rail office in Koyambedu, the police said.

Meanwhile, a man approached the police and filed a separate complaint against Mariadoss, who had asked the man to deposit money into the bank account given in the advertisement.

"Mariadoss also accepted ₹75,000 from the man and demanded ₹6 lakh after the getting the 'job'," the police said.

Mariadoss was sent to judicial remand. Further investigation is on to nab the others involved in the fake job racket.
