Overview of Chennai Metro Rail Works

Track Progress as on 31/08/2015 (ATA-01)

In corridor II from Chennai Central to St. Thomas Mount, Track work completed for entire elevated stretch of 24788m from Thirumangalam to St. Thomas Mount and all 27 turnouts have been completed. In corridor I from Washermanpet to Airport, Saidapet ramp to airport (elevated section), 12142m out of 18723 of plinth concrete completed. 18 out of 23 turnouts between Saidapet ramp to airport completed. Casting of scissor crossover work is in progress at Airport.

In underground section between Thirumangalam ramp to Shenoy Nagar, 2651m out of 4183m concrete completed in down line and up line work is in progress. In Depot, Track work completed for entire depot length of 14606m and 41 numbers of turnouts were laid.

Chennai Metro gets its first Woman Chief Security Officer

She will be in charge of providing safety and security to the Access Control and the assets of the Metro Rail, besides carrying out the anti-terror drill and anti-sabotage check. Tmt K. Bhavaneeswari served earlier as deputy commissioner of police, Kilpauk, Chennai city and also as Superintendent of Police of 'Q' branch before assuming charges in CMRL. She has also efficiently handled duties in CB-CID, vigilance and anti-corruption and also city law and order. She had also received the prestigious excellence in

investigation medal from the Honorable Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu in 2007. Chennai Metro Rail Limited (CMRL) being a rapid transit system and a prominent infrastructure of the Chennai City is a rewarding one for the Chennai commuters.





Safety comes first for CMRL:

CMRL has taken lot of efforts in ensuring the safety and security of the Passengers, Trains, Employees, Metro Stations and Depot. Security is based on prevention and prevention begins with

design. The design strategies along with security technology were clubbed effectively by CMRL to achieve mobility, safety and security. Credible security technology has been put in place in CMRL where the Metro Stations and Depot are fully covered by CCTV cameras, Access Control and Intrusion Detection Systems. To have a holistic approach towards an infallible security, Tamil Nadu Police has taken up the Surveillance and Guard Duty at Metro Stations and Depot. Various kinds of specific trainings are being imparted to Tamil Nadu Special Police with regard to the Metro Security. All the best practices in the field of security would be adopted to ensure that CMRL is the safest and secure Metro Rails in the world. This mixture of design strategies, security technology and policing along with the customer cooperation would ensure our Moto "The Safe & Secure CMRL".

Rolling Stock work progress - Aug 2015

The total order quantity for design, manufacture, supply, testing and commissioning of trains from Alstom Transport is 42. Out of which 9 trains are imported from Alstom, Brazil and remaining 33 trains are being delivered from Alstom Factory set up at Sricity, Andhra Pradesh as a measure of promoting indigenization and technology transfer of Metro train manufacture.





Trains delivered to depot

A total of 25 trains including the 9 trains of import category, have been delivered to CMRL Koyambedu Depot.

Trains under testing at CMRL facility

- Trains 10 to 17 have completed all tests in Depot and Mainline.
- Trains 18 to 25 are under various stages of static inspection, tests in Depot and Mainline.

Trains commissioned and conditionally accepted by CMRL

- Nine trains have been issued with completion certificate and seven among these nine trains have been conditionally accepted by CMRL in June 2015.
- The accepted 7 trains are put under revenue service of Stage-1 section of

CMRL from June 2015. Maintenance activities on these 7 trains are carried out by CMRL Rolling Stock Maintenance Team and the warranty obligation is done by the contractor.

Trains under manufacturing at Sricity:

- The trains 26 and 27 have been cleared for dispatch, based on the completion of the tests / checks for the trains. It is planned that the trains will be delivered to depot on the 2nd of Sept 2015.
- The trains 28 and 29 have completed all Routine Static tests at Alstom factory, Sricity and final inspection for dispatch is under progress. These trains also will be delivered to CMRL in a week's time.
- Trains 30 to 35 are under various stages of production, as per the schedule, at Alstom factory, Sricity.
