

CMAML Signs Consultancy Agreement for Guindy Multimodal Transit Hub

Chennai Metro Asset Management Limited (CMAML) had signed a consultancy agreement with M/s CBRE South Asia Private Limited, New Delhi, for the preparation of the Detailed Feasibility Report (DFR), Detailed Project Report (DPR), Market Analysis, Transaction Advisory Services, Land Use Report and Concept Plans for the proposed Multimodal Transit Hub at Guindy. The consultancy contract has been awarded at a value of ₹76.70 lakh.

The proposed transit hub aims to provide seamless connectivity between the Guindy Metro Station, Suburban Railway Station and MTC Bus Terminus, improving commuter convenience and traffic circulation at one of Chennai's busiest transport hubs. Phase 2 Corridor 5 Achieves Final U-Girder Milestone

Chennai Metro Rail Limited, along with General Consultant AEON and contractor L&T, achieved a major construction milestone with the successful casting of the final U-Girder for Corridor 5 (ECV-02) under Phase 2. The completion marks the successful production of 824 U-Girders, one of the largest precast programmes undertaken for the Chennai Metro project.

The 43-acre casting yard produced over 5,800 precast components required for the 13.1 km elevated corridor and introduced India's first automated hydraulic U-Girder mould system, improving construction efficiency, safety and quality. Thiru. T. Archunan, Director (Projects), CMRL, along with senior officials from CMRL, AEON and L&T, witnessed the milestone.

Music Metro Magic Returns for Vijay Antony Live Concert

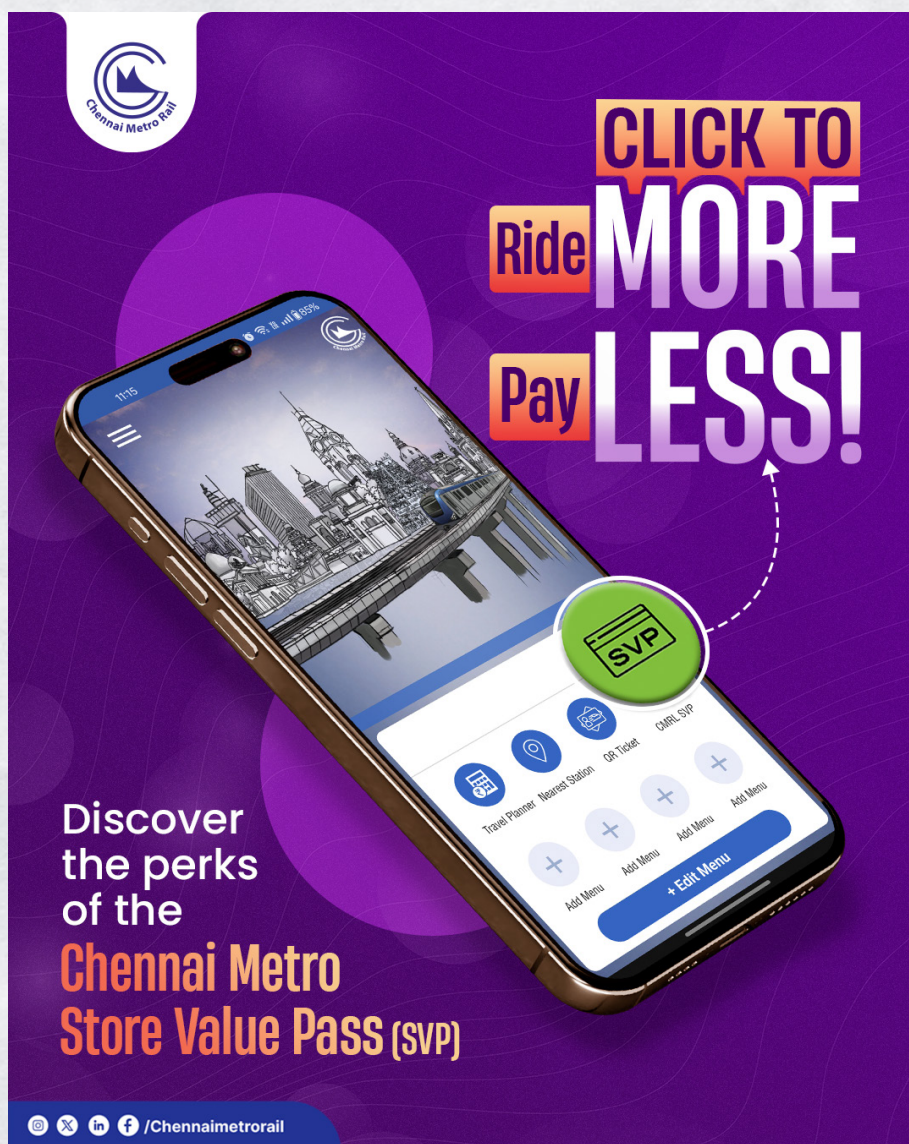
